**Davidson County Meals on Wheels saves lives!**

Last year volunteers saved the lives or rescued 22 homebound seniors—14 of whom had fallen and lay helpless, and the other 8 who were in medical distress. What did it take? All it took was a volunteer who showed up, saw the need, and made a phone call for help—that's it! Meals on Wheels is a ministry of mercy that organizes healthy individuals to visit and check on homebound people, while delivering a hot noontime meal. Senior Services is preparing to launch a new Meals on Wheels route in the Southmont / High Rock area in 2026 and is looking for volunteers to deliver the meals. If you have a vehicle to drive and can give two hours of your time—you can help launch the route and decrease the number of people on the waiting list!
